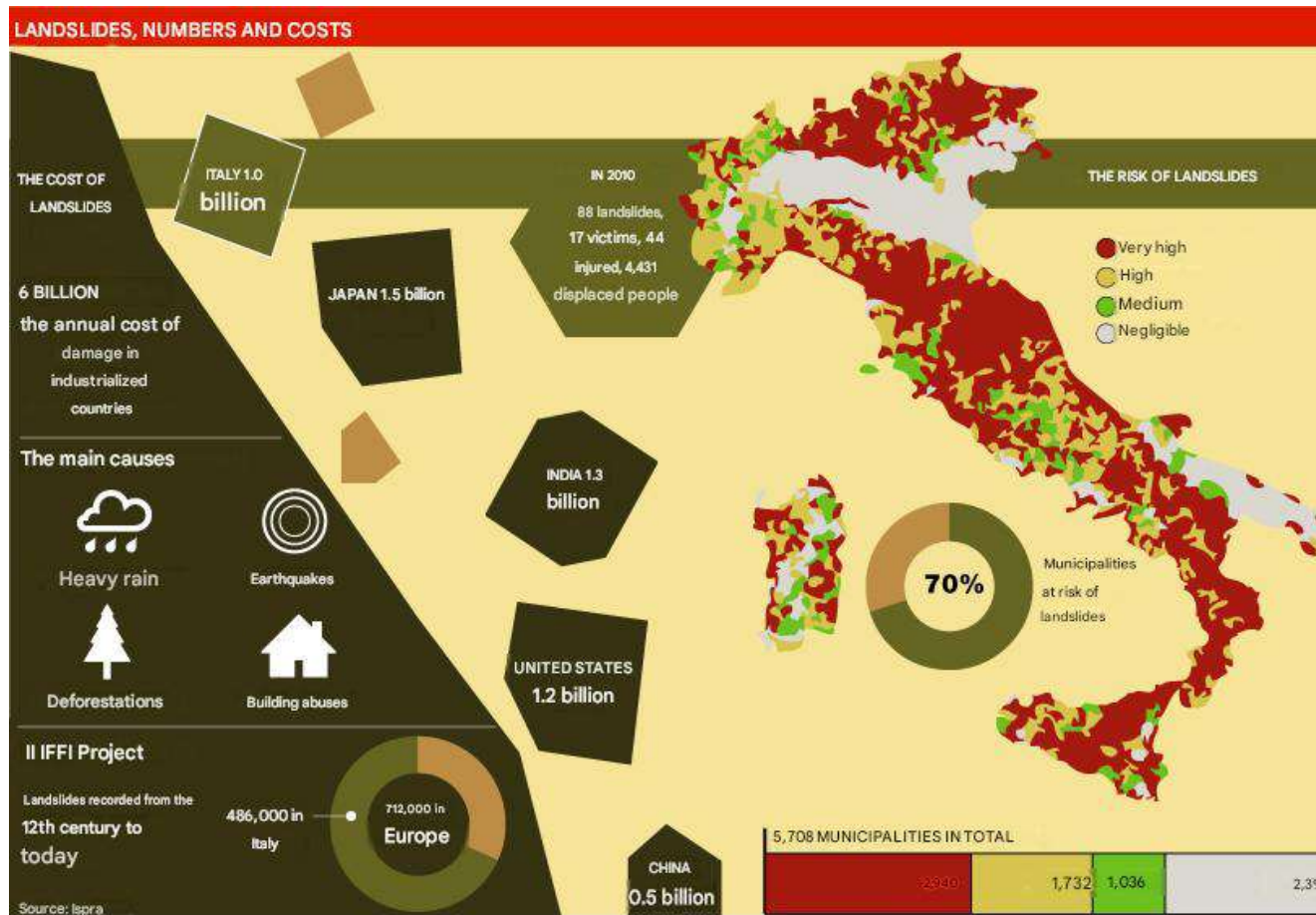
Main activities 2025/2026

Working groups *Stati generali di Confprofessioni* - Milano Italy Environment - Energy and Economic development

- Adequate compensation for professionals;
- Lower compliance obligations;
- Protection of professional autonomy and independence;
- Recognition of the professional's neutral and advisory role;
- Permanent technical working groups with national and local governments to promote legislative simplification and digitalisation of procedures based on professionals' expertise;
- Facilitate access to financial resources and capital markets;
- Incentivise business growth and market competitiveness;
- Promote university education and encourage spin-offs;
- Public spending review.

- 486.000 in Italy
- 712.000 in Europe
- 68,2% European landslide are located in Italy
- 5.708 Municipalities involved
- 1 billion/year costs (Italy)

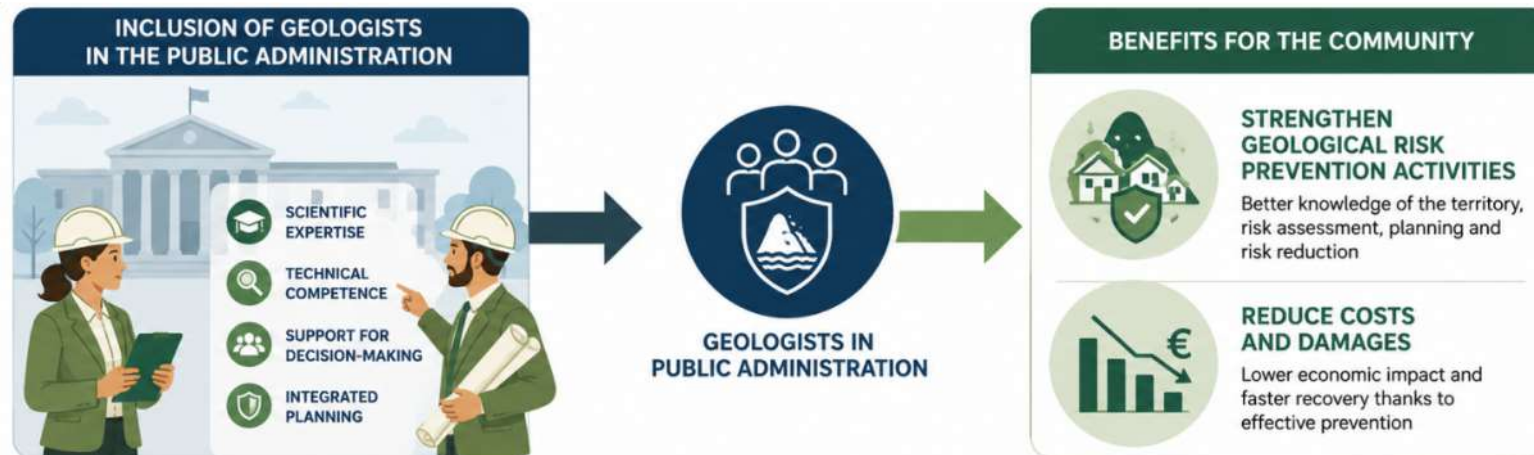
Niscemi

- 350 million cubic meters of material
- Landslide front 4 km breaking surface >50m deep
- permeable sands and calcarenites on a base of plastic and impermeable clays
- 880 buildings are located within the "red zone" on the edge of the landslide



Challenges and outlook
